

Additional notes:

- 1. The PCF for IPReg authorised persons fall into several categories including 'Attorneys who are retired/inactive/employed solely in industry', 'All Other Attorneys', 'Sole Traders' and 'Attorneys/Professional employed by sole traders'. An individual may also be registered to one or both of the Patent Attorney and Trade Mark Attorney registers.
- 2. For the purposes of this analysis, we have used the 'All Attorneys' fee for one Register of £170 (based on figures from IPReg that the majority of authorised persons paying a PCF are in a private practice and under one register i.e. not dually qualified or sole traders).
- 3. IPReg also regulates entities and charges a base fee of £420 plus a variable fee for each Attorney/professional employed with different fees for dually qualified persons.
