



### Additional notes:

- 1. The total income collected through the PCF is split between the individual's fee at 40% of total PCF and, the firm's fee at 60% of the total PCF.
- 2. The PCF paid by each individual solicitor totalled £328 for 2011/12.
- 3. The total PCF income to be collected from all firms was £56.9M in 2011/12. Each firm is charged a fee based on their total turnover for a given year; the rate of the fee charged to each firm is based on different bandings of turnover.
- 4. Alternative Business Structure (ABS) firms will be charged at a turnover based fee which is calculated, with some adaption, on the same basis as traditional firms.
- 5. Contributions to the compensation fund are collected at the same time as the PCF and in 2011/12 was charged at £60 for an individual solicitor and £772 per firm.
