Extension notice issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007

This letter is an extension notice issued under paragraph 21(5) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the "Act"). The words used in this extension notice have the meanings given to them in the Act.

On 16 September 2015 we received an application from the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA), to alter its regulatory arrangements relating to its Regulatory Reform Programme. Paragraph 21(4) of Schedule 4 to the Act sets out an initial decision period of 28 days within which the Legal Services Board may make a decision on the application; paragraph 21(5) allows for this period to be extended.

We are continuing our assessment of the application and have concluded that we need to extend the initial decision period to allow more time to consider additional information requested from the SRA and to complete the process. Therefore, and in accordance with paragraphs 21(5), (6) and (7) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board hereby extends the initial decision period by 90 days from the date of receipt of the application, to 14 December 2015.
