Finance report for June 2014

Recommendation

The Board is invited to note and to comment on the Finance report.

Introduction

- 1. This paper provides a brief commentary about the period ending 30 June 2014. A financial report is attached (**Appendix 1**).
- 2. This report covers the first month of the year and spending is largely in line with expectations and forecasted variances.
- 3. Overall position spending to the end of June is £761,276 against a budget of £830,008 resulting in an underspend of £68,731 (£17,867 in 2013).
- 4. Cash position following supplier, legal, HMRC and salary payments in June, the funds held in the bank have decreased from £6.13m to £5.90m.

Points to note

- 5. An analysis of the main spending headings reveals:
 - a) Board Costs The Board has one vacant Member position. Increased travel costs are as a consequence that Board Members are drawn from areas which are not exclusively London-centric.
 - **b) Accommodation Costs** We are taking advantage of the offer to use rooms provided by the Medical Research Council on a 'free of charge basis' when these are available. This will reduce costs in this area.
 - c) Outsourced Services and IT Costs We continue to make savings on these costs partly as a result of our new IT support contract and partly by bringing 'in-house' some services previously outsourced.
 - d) Legal and Associated Costs The legal costs include the actual charges to the end of June. Although a proportion of our costs have been awarded following the outcome of the judicial review, the claimants have appealed and, following the oral hearing held on 9 May, the courts have granted the claimants leave to appeal. This means that any potential refund of costs will not be known for some months.
