Summary:

We are developing an impact assessment for the commencement of Part 5 of Legal Services Act 2007, which will allow alternative business structures (**ABS**). The attached presentation sets out the background and the key conclusions. Although this is work in progress and does not have to be finalised until March 2011, we would value early comments from the Board on our approach.

We intend to discuss the impact assessment in detail with Council for Licensed Conveyancers (**CLC**) and Solicitors Regulation Authority (**SRA**), who have provided data during the course of its development. We plan to hold one or two workshops in January for interested parties to discuss the draft findings. Board Members will be most welcome to attend.

The working draft will be circulated post-meeting for initial comment by 7 January.
