Request:

- Did the Legal Services Board pay for a NLA (Newspaper Licensing Agency) or CLA (Copyright Licensing Agency) media license in 2013-2014?
- If so, how much did the Legal Services Board pay for the licenses in 2013-2014 (please provide the figures separately)?
- Did the Legal Services Board pay for other media licenses in 2013-2014? Please list any other media licenses the council subscribed to and how much was paid for them in 2013-2014.

Response:

I write in response to your email of 5 February in which you request information about the amounts that the LSB paid in the 2013/14 financial year for media licenses. Your enquiry has been considered in accordance with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that the LSB holds this information. In 2013/14, for the purpose of procuring medial licenses, the LSB paid:

- £370.80 to the National Licensing Agency, and
- £538.80 to the Copyright Licensing Authority.

The LSB did not pay for any other media licenses in that year.
