Thank you for your email of 24 October 2018. You have asked: "Does the LSB treat the legal regulatory bodies it oversees as State Agencies and/or as emanations of the State?" Your request has been treated as a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am writing to advise you that the information you request is not held by the Legal Services Board (LSB).

The LSB is a statutory body created by, and operates within the framework of the Legal Services Act 2007, under which it is the oversight regulator for approved regulators under that Act. The LSB has not been required to reach a view on whether these approved regulators are to be treated as state agencies and/or emanations of the state. We therefore do not hold the information you request.
