**Extension Notice issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007**

I am writing to you with regard to issuing an Extension Notice pursuant under paragraph 21(5) Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the "Act"). The words used in this Extension Notice have the meanings given to them in the Act.

On 13 December 2010 we received the Faculty Office's application, to alter its regulatory arrangements. Paragraph 21(4) requires the Board to make a decision with regard to the application within 28 days of receiving the application (the "initial decision period").

After an initial assessment of the application, and in accordance with paragraphs 21(5), (6) and (7) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board hereby extends the initial decision period until the end of Monday, 28 February 2011.

The extension of the initial decision period is required due to the complexity of the issues raised in the application, the additional time required by the Faculty Office to clarify a number of points regarding the application, and the additional time required by us to assess the application.

This Extension Notice is to be deemed made on and effective from 6 January 2011 and will expire on Monday, 28 February 2011.
