

Direction 40 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA)

- 1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the Act).
- 2. Unless stated otherwise, words in this direction are used as they are defined in the Act.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board has directed that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements be treated as exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:
 - Alterations by the SRA to add immigration work to Rule 8.6 the Practice
 Framework Rules 2011 and to add immigration work to Rule 7.1(b) of the
 Authorisation Rules for Legal Services Bodies and Licensable Bodies 2011 to
 authorise licensed bodies to provide immigration work when also authorised to
 undertake a reserved legal activity.
- 4. A copy of the alteration was submitted to the Board on 14 March 2012.
- 5. This direction is deemed to be made on and to be effective from 18 April 2012.
