

Direction 36 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Bar Standards Board (BSB)

1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the “**Act**”).
2. Unless stated otherwise, words defined in the Act have the same meaning when used in this direction.
3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board hereby directs that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements are exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:
 - Alterations to the Code of Conduct and the Bar Training Regulations to amend references to ‘Authorised Body’ with the definition agreed by the Bar Standards Board Standards Committee and Board.
 - Alterations to the Practising Certificate Rules to amend Rule 11.4 and Rule 12.1 to cross refer to paragraph 204 (c) instead of paragraph 204 (b) in the Code of Conduct.
4. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from 15 February 2012.
