

Direction 36 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Bar Standards Board (BSB)

- 1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the "**Act**").
- 2. Unless stated otherwise, words defined in the Act have the same meaning when used in this direction.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board hereby directs that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements are exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:
 - Alterations to the Code of Conduct and the Bar Training Regulations to amend references to 'Authorised Body' with the definition agreed by the Bar Standards Board Standards Committee and Board.
 - Alterations to the Practising Certificate Rules to amend Rule 11.4 and Rule 12.1 to cross refer to paragraph 204 (c) instead of paragraph 204 (b) in the Code of Conduct.
- 4. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from 15 February 2012.
