

Direction 77 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to ILEX Professional Standards Limited

- 1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the Act).
- 2. Unless stated otherwise, words in this direction are used as they are defined in the Act.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board has directed that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements be treated as exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4.

Alterations by the ILEX Professional Standards Limited to the following CILEx rules:

- Probate Rights Certification Rules, Reserved Instrument Certification Rules, Litigation Certification Rules and Immigration Certification Rules: definition of "Investigation, Disciplinary and Appeals Rules"
- Authorisation Rules
- Code of Conduct
- Accounts Rules
- Investigation, Disciplinary and Appeals Rules
- Professional Indemnity Insurance Rules (and IPS minimum wording)
- Compensation Fund Rules

The majority of the changes are to terminology and arise from the coming into force of the Legal Services Act (Chartered Institute of Legal Executives) (Modification of Functions Order) 2014.

- 5. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from 9 December 2014.
