

Direction 78 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Council for Licensed Conveyancers

- 1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the Act).
- 2. Unless stated otherwise, words in this direction are used as they are defined in the Act.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board has directed that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements be treated as exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:
 - Council for Licensed Conveyancers (CLC) Handbook, including the CLC's Licensed Body (ABS) Licensing Framework and CLC's Adjudication Panel Rules. Technical alterations relating to periods of time for appeals against decisions of the CLC acting as a licensing authority, as well as alterations to prescribed time periods for temporary ABS licences.
 - The CLC's Anti-Money Laundering and Combating Terrorist Financing Code, insertion of certain provisions already contained within the CLC's Mortgage Fraud Code.
 - Removal of paragraph from the introduction to the CLC Handbook that is no longer relevant.
- 4. A copy of the alteration was submitted to the Board on Monday 1 December 2014.
- 5. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from Monday 15 December 2014.
