

Direction 84 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives ILEx Professional Standards¹

- 1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the Act).
- 2. Unless stated otherwise, words in this direction are used as they are defined in the Act.
- 3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board has directed that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements be treated as exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:

Any alterations to the regulatory arrangements of ILEx Professional Standards (IPS) made solely to give effect to its change of name to 'CILEx Regulation'.

- 4. A copy of the alteration was submitted to the Board on 20 February 2015.
- 5. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from 24 February 2015.
