

Direction 84 issued under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives ILEX Professional Standards¹

1. This is a direction issued pursuant to paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Legal Services Act 2007 (the Act).
2. Unless stated otherwise, words in this direction are used as they are defined in the Act.
3. In accordance with paragraph 19(3) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Board has directed that the following alterations to regulatory arrangements be treated as exempt alterations for the purposes of paragraph 19(2)(c) of Schedule 4:

Any alterations to the regulatory arrangements of ILEX Professional Standards (IPS) made solely to give effect to its change of name to 'CILEx Regulation'.

4. A copy of the alteration was submitted to the Board on 20 February 2015.
5. This direction is to be deemed made on and to be effective from 24 February 2015.
