

### **IELTS Requirements for post graduate courses**

Most universities require between a 6.0 and 7.5 for postgraduate courses. Below are a few of particular interest:

#### **Cambridge**

7.5 is required as overall minimum score for Law courses

#### **Kings College London**

7.5 is required for all social science and humanities courses

#### **Queen Mary University of London**

7.0 is required for post graduate law courses

#### **Manchester University**

Language entry requirements for the School of Law are listed and change according to country of origin. Required score is up to 7.5

#### **Newcastle University**

7.5 is required overall for modern languages courses. Applies to all students for whom "...English is not your mother tongue"

For psychology courses they require 8.0 in academic reading

#### **University of Liverpool**

7.5 is required for Medicine

#### **University of Warwick**

8.00 is required for Marketing & Strategy courses, otherwise 7.00 is required for social sciences

Several American institutions in fact require 8 and above, for example, Columbia University requires 8.5 for Journalism (the highest requirement of any university) and Ohio State University (IELTS 8/8.5 for Law). The highest IELTS band required in the UK is for MSc Marketing at the University of Warwick (IELTS 8)
